

Equine Influenza Policy

With confirmed cases of equine flu as close as Plumpton, the Bexhill Horse Show Committee have taken advice from both the British Horse Society and Cliffe Equine Hospital, vets on call for the event. The following decision has been made:

All equines attending the show will have to have an up to date flu vaccination.

You must ensure that the horse (or pony) has received two injections for primary vaccination against equine influenza given no less than 21 days and no more than 60 days apart. Only these two injections need to have been given before a horse/pony can attend.

In addition, if sufficient time has elapsed a first booster injection must be given no less than 120 days and no more than 180 days after the second injection of the primary vaccination course.

Booster injections must be given at intervals of not more than one year apart and not within 7 days of the show.

This means any booster vaccinations must have been administered on or before 18th May 2026.

All passports/vaccination records will be checked before any horse/pony is unloaded. Anyone who does not have valid certification will be told to leave the show ground. On arrival please bring your passport (which is a legal requirement) to the secretary's trailer, BEFORE you unload any animal, to be checked.

We are a responsible show and have the welfare of the animals at the forefront of our mind.
